HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 467, L.D. 638, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Law Regarding the Sale of Alcohol on Golf Courses"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the first line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "in" the following: 'private' and in the 2nd line from the end (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "a" the following 'private'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the prohibition on the sale of liquor for consumption in the parking lot of a golf course applies only to a private course.
