Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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4 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1075, sub-§2**, as enacted by PL 1995, c.
195, §2, is amended to read:

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8 **2. Sales for consumption on slopes or in course parking**
lots prohibited. Nothing in this section permits a ski area to
sell liquor for consumption on the slopes away from the licensed
area or a golf course to sell liquor for consumption on in the
10 parking lot of the course away-from-the-licensed-area.

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SUMMARY

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16 This bill repeals the provision in current law that
prohibits the sale of liquor on golf courses for consumption away
from the licensed area. The sale for consumption in the course
18 parking lot is still prohibited.
