### STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 118TH LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "4" to H.P. 469, L.D. 640, Bill, "An Act Requiring Qualified Investigation of Certain Truck-related and Bus-related Fatalities"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 by striking out all of the 2nd blocked paragraph (page 1, lines 17 to 29 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'If the accident results in serious bodily injury or death of any person, the investigation must be conducted by an officer who has 28 met the training standards of a full-time law enforcement 30 officer. A law enforcement officer who investigates an accident involving a bus or truck with a gross vehicle weight rating or a 32 registered weight in excess of 10,000 pounds that results in the death of any person shall request a certified accident 34 reconstructionist and the Bureau of State Police Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Unit to assist in the investigation of the 36 accident. The Attorney General shall designate an assistant attorney general familiar with federal commercial vehicle laws and regulations to serve as a resource to any district attorney 38 who initiates a prosecution arising from an accident involving a 40 bus or truck with a gross vehicle weight rating or a registered weight in excess of 10,000 pounds that results in the death of 42 any person.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

#### **FISCAL NOTE**

The additional costs associated with requiring investigations of certain truck and bus fatalities can be

absorbed by the Department of the Attorney General and the Department of Public Safety utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

## SUMMARY

The amendment requires a law enforcement officer who investigates an accident involving a bus or truck with a gross 8 vehicle weight rating or a registered weight of 10,000 pounds or more that results in the death of any person to request a 10 certified accident reconstructionist and the Bureau of State Police Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Unit to assist in the 12 investigation of the accident. The amendment also requires the Attorney General to designate an assistant attorney general 14 familiar with federal commercial vehicle laws and regulations to 16 serve as a resource to any district attorney who initiates a prosecution arising from an accident involving a bus or truck 18 that weighs in excess of 10,000 pounds that results in the death of a person.
