Resolve, to Allow Donald Hebert to Retain a Certain Structure in Exchange for the Removal of Another Structure.

Sec. 1. Authority to retain structure. Resolved: That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, chapter 3, subchapter I, Article 2-B, rules adopted by the Board of Environmental Protection and ordinances adopted by the Town of Madawaska, Donald Hebert may retain the sun room attached to his residence on Lot 284 in the Town of Madawaska, provided that he removes the storage shed located on the same property and restores the area of the storage shed to natural vegetation.

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12 SUMMARY

This resolve allows Donald Hebert to retain a sun room that is attached to his residence in the Town of Madawaska in violation of the town's water setback requirements. In exchange for retaining the sun room, Donald Hebert must remove a storage shed located on the same property and restore the area of the shed to natural vegetation.
