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The Legislature will require a General Fund appropriation of \$500 in fiscal year 1997-98 for the miscellaneous costs of the Commission to Examine Rate Setting and the Financing of Maine's 8 Long-term Care Facilities. The additional costs associated with providing staffing assistance to the commission can be absorbed by the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds members to the Commission to Examine 16 Rate Setting and the Financing of Maine's Long-term Care Facilities. It adds duties from the suggestions of the informal 18 study of nursing home rates during the summer of 1996 and from another bill. It adds an appropriation section and fiscal note 20 to the resolve.
