Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §17-B is enacted to read:

6 §17-B. Funds from the Federal Government and private sources

8 The State Court Administrator may accept, use, expend and  
10 dispose of, on behalf of the State, funds, equipment, supplies,  
12 materials and property from any agency of the United States or  
14 from any private foundation or other private source.

20 donations or other funds from any agency of the United States or  
from a private source.
