COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 223, L.D. 682, "Resolve, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey the Interest of the State in Certain Real Estate in the Unorganized Territory"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The funds received through sales of these parcels will accrue as dedicated revenue to the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund. The amount of additional dedicated revenue will depend on the prices received for the parcels.'
