Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3           **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §13751, sub-§3**, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 710,  
4 §5, is amended to read:

3. **Rules.** The board shall establish by rule the criteria  
which that each drug outlet must meet to qualify for registration  
8 in each classification designated in subsection 2. The board may  
issue various types of certificates with varying restrictions to  
10 the outlets referred to in subsection 2, paragraph A when the  
board determines it necessary by reason of the type of drug  
12 outlet requesting a certificate.

The board may not require drug outlets, manufacturers or  
wholesalers to report changes in the membership of their  
16 respective boards of directors.

**SUMMARY**

Current law requires drug outlets, manufacturers and  
22 wholesalers to report changes in ownership or control of such an  
entity as well as changes in the officers of the corporation.  
24 This bill clarifies that changes in the members of the board of  
directors, exclusive of the officers, need not be reported.
