2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-I, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

6 4. Veterans. The provisions of this section do no apply to veterans who reside in the Maine Veterans' Homes.

8 **Sec. 2. 37-B MRSA §601**, as repealed and replaced by PL 1993,
10 c. 680, Pt. A, §34, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

12 Medical eligibility for reimbursement under the Medicaid
14 program for residents of the Maine Veterans' Homes must be
16 determined using the Medicaid eligibility criteria in effect
18 prior to July 1, 1994.

20 SUMMARY

22 This bill exempts veteran residents of the Maine Veterans' Homes from the provisions on medical eligibility for reimbursement under the Medicaid program.
