2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6 **Whereas**, a limit on the tuition rate that may be charged to
the Town of Dennysville is being set for the students attending
the Edmunds School for the 1997-98 school year; and

8
10 **Whereas**, the school year may begin before the 90 days has
expired; and

12 **Whereas**, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
16 safety; now, therefore, be it

18 **Sec. 1. Establish the tuition rate for school year 1997-98. Resolved:**
That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A,
20 section 3304, the per student tuition charge for students from
the Town of Dennysville attending the Edmunds School is limited
22 to \$2,650 for the 1997-98 school year.

24 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.
