

An Act to Allow Signs to Change an Unlimited Number of Times per Day.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1914, sub-§11, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 390, §3, is amended to read:

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A. For the purpose of this subsection, changeable message board signs are those signs in which the message may be electronically, mechanically or manually changed by the complete substitution or replacement of one display by another. The message on changeable message board signs may ~~not be changed more than once in any 4-hour~~ an unlimited number of times during any 24-hour period.

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SUMMARY

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This bill permits the message on changeable message board signs to be changed an unlimited number of times per day.
