## **'FISCAL NOTE**

8 The additional costs associated with implementing these confidentiality requirements can be absorbed by the Law and 10 Legislative Reference Library utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

16 This amendment clarifies that the Maine State Library and the Law and Legislative Reference Library are not municipal libraries. It also repeals a transition provision no longer needed and provides a January 1, 1998 effective date for the bill. It also adds a fiscal note.
