Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S6725.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the first line (page 1, line 45 in amendment) by striking out the following: "16" and inserting in its place the following: '1'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S6725.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the first line (page 1, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "16" and inserting in its place the following: '1'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S6725.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the first line (page 2, line 1 in amendment) by striking out the following: "16" and inserting in its place the following: '1'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S6726.~~" in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 29 in amendment) by striking out the following: "16th to December 15th" and inserting in its place the following: '1st to November 30th'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S6726.~~" in subsection 2 in the first line (page 2, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "16th" and inserting in its place the following: '1st'
