## **FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment will result in the loss of dedicated revenues collected from registration fees by the Propane and Natural Gas Board within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation beginning in fiscal year 1999-2000. The estimated losses of dedicated revenue are \$3,500 and \$700 in fiscal years 1999-2000 and 2000-01, respectively.

The Department of Professional and Financial Regulation will incur some minor additional costs to submit 2 required reports to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

## SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation to study education and training requirements for the propane and natural gas helper category created by the bill. The department is directed to report its findings and recommendations for rule changes by November 15, 1997. This amendment also requires the new category to be reviewed by the department and repeals the category, unless continued or modified by law, on September 1, 1999.
