COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 551, L.D. 742, Bill, "An Act to Promote Wildlife Rehabilitation Centers"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

General Fund	(\$1,859)	(\$3,079)
Other Funds	(100)	(165)

The additional sales tax exemption for wildlife rehabilitation permit holders will decrease General Fund revenue by \$1,859 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$3,079 in fiscal year 1998-99. The corresponding decreases in dedicated revenue to the Local Government Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing will be \$100 and \$165, respectively.

The Bureau of Taxation will incur some minor additional costs to notify affected retailers. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
