Sec. 3. Nonlapsing funds. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any balance remaining on June 30, 1997 in the General Fund Maine Emergency Management Agency account in the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services may not lapse but must be carried forward to June 30, 1998 to be used to carry out inspections for the Dam Safety Program as approved by Public Law 1997, chapter 1.

Sec. 4. Effective date. The section of this bill that amends the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 37-B, section 1065, subsection 5 takes effect October 1, 1998.'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment delays the effective date and reduces the General Fund appropriation to \$36,048 in fiscal year 1998-99. This amendment may also reduce amounts that would lapse to the General Fund.

SUMMARY

This amendment delays the effective date and reduces the General Fund appropriation. The amendment also provides that any balance remaining on June 30, 1997 in the General Fund Maine Emergency Management Agency account in the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services may not lapse but must be carried forward to June 30, 1998 to be used to carry out inspections for the Dam Safety Program as approved by Public Law 1997, chapter 1.
