
SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 230, L.D. 799, Bill, "An Act to Limit the Type of Hunting Equipment Used by Hunters Who Have Already Tagged a Deer"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of paragraph N (page 1, lines 27 to 33 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'N. Has already tagged a deer and hunts in November by any method other than with a shotgun, unless the person is a moose permittee or subpermittee hunting in that person's respective zone. This paragraph does not apply to hunting in the unorganized territory.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment provides that the prohibition on hunting with certain types of equipment applies only in November to hunting by any method other than with a shotgun. The amendment also provides that this prohibition does not apply to hunting in the unorganized territory.
