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FISCAL NOTE

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The Bureau of Insurance, within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, will incur some minor additional costs to redistribute assessment costs to include health maintenance organizations. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment clarifies that the direct gross premium from the health maintenance organization division or line of business of a nonprofit hospital or medical or health care service organization is not included in the assessment base used in calculating the assessment upon a nonprofit hospital or medical or health care service organization for the expenses of maintaining the Bureau of Insurance.

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The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
