20 Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "<u>§1254.</u>" in subsection 1 in the 2nd line from the end (page 1, 22 line 40 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "<u>\$100,000</u>" the following: '<u>, the work is a normal maintenance</u> 24 activity routinely performed by that department or political subdivision or county, city, town, township or plantation' 26

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "**§1254.**" in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 46 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "or 30 rule" the following: 'or if the project involves construction of new facilities or substantial capacity improvements to existing 32 facilities'
