8 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.  
10 This bill seeks to take the money that is currently allocated  
12 annually to fund retirement for teachers and school district  
employees and funds for construction and transportation and  
integrate them all into the general purpose aid formula. The  
bill also seeks to require school units to fund retirement for  
their own teachers and employees after July 1, 1998.
