The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Special Session of the 118th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.'
