COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 603, L.D. 828, Bill, "An Act to Require Public Insurers to Supply Insurance Data to Schools and Municipalities"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. 24 MRSA § 2307-C is enacted to read:

§2307-C. Information concerning school administrative unit's experience rating

Notwithstanding any provisions of law governing confidentiality, a nonprofit hospital or medical service organization shall provide information concerning a school administrative unit's own experience rating and claims history as members covered under a group policy or contract to that school administrative unit at its request and to the municipality in which the unit is located if the municipality so requests.

Sec. 2. 24-A MRSA § 2803-B is enacted to read:

§2803-B. Information concerning school administrative unit's experience rating

Notwithstanding any provisions of law governing confidentiality, an insurer shall provide information concerning a school administrative unit's own experience rating and claims history as members covered under a group policy or contract to that school administrative unit at its request and to the municipality in which the unit is located if the municipality so requests.

**§4224-B. Information concerning school administrative unit's
experience rating**

Notwithstanding any provisions of law governing confidentiality, a health maintenance organization shall provide information concerning a school administrative unit's own experience rating and claims history as members covered under a group policy or contract to that school administrative unit at its request and to the municipality in which the unit is located if the municipality so requests.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and clarifies that nonprofit hospital or medical service organizations, insurers and health maintenance organizations are required to provide school administrative units with information concerning their own experience ratings and claims history as members covered under a group policy or contract at the unit's request and to the municipalities in which the school unit is located at the municipality's request.
