SUMMARY

amendment replaces the bill and clarifies that This 18 nonprofit hospital or medical service organizations, insurers and health maintenance organizations are required to provide school 20 administrative units with information concerning their own experience ratings and claims history as members covered under a 22 group policy or contract at the unit's request and to the municipalities in which the school unit is located at the 24 municipality's request.
