Snowmobile Clubs.**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7824, sub-§2-B is enacted to read:**

6 2-B. Club membership; fees. The fees set out in subsection
8 2 apply only if the owner provides satisfactory evidence of
10 membership in a snowmobile club. If the owner fails to provide
12 satisfactory evidence of membership in a snowmobile club, an
14 additional 10% must be assessed on the fees set out in subsection
16 2 and that additional amount must be credited to the Snowmobile
18 Trail Fund of the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and
20 Lands for use pursuant to subsection 4.

16 SUMMARY

18 This bill requires that owners of snowmobile who fail to
20 provide satisfactory evidence of membership in a snowmobile club
22 must pay an additional 10% of the fee to register their
snowmobiles. The additional 10% is credited to the Department of
Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands.
