

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated
from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

22 This bill provides a \$1,500,000 General Fund appropriation
24 towards the cost of building Poland High School. This amount
along with \$18,000,000 committed by the Department of Education
26 for the project will provide the necessary \$19,500,000 for
construction costs.
