Sec. 1. Legislative Employee Salary Review Committee. Resolved:

2 That a legislative employee salary review committee, referred to
in this resolve as the "review committee," is established,
4 consisting of the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the House
of Representatives and the Executive Director of the Legislative
6 Council; and be it further

Sec. 2. Duties. Resolved:

8 That the review committee shall
obtain information from the other 49 states regarding the size of
10 the legislatures, the length of the legislative session, the
number and type of legislative employees and the rate of pay and
12 benefits for legislators and legislative employees. The review
committee shall compare other states with this State with regard
14 to the information obtained. The review committee shall report
its findings to the Second Regular Session of the 118th
16 Legislature by January 1, 1998.

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SUMMARY

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22 This resolve directs the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk
of the House of Representatives and the Executive Director of the
Legislative Council to collect information about the pay and
24 benefits for legislative employees of other states and report
that information to the Second Regular Session of the 118th
26 Legislature.
