COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 638, L.D. 863, Bill, "An  
Act to Amend the North Yarmouth-Cumberland Town Line"

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the  
emergency preamble the following:

**'Mandate preamble.** This measure requires one or more local  
units of government to expand or modify activities so as to  
necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does  
not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures.  
Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21,  
two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have  
determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the  
summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill requires the Town of Cumberland to maintain sewer  
lines that it is not currently required to maintain. The  
additional costs of this state mandate can not be determined at  
this time. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote  
of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the  
constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local  
costs.'
