2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. P&SL 1979, c. 45, §6, 3rd sentence from the end** is repealed
and the following enacted in its place:

6 One hundred percent of the total expenses must be assessed
8 between the towns in the same proportion as the number of
10 resident pupils in each town is to the total number of pupils in
the district. The number of pupils must be determined in
accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section
6004.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill repeals the current sharing of school costs
18 between the towns of Wells and Ogunquit based on state valuation
and replaces it with a sharing of costs based on the number of
20 pupils in the school from each town.
