26	FISCAL NOTE
28	The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda
30	enacted during the First Special Session of the 118th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to
32	the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.
34	If approved by the voters, the resolution will increase
36	costs to the Legislature if the Legislature votes to extend its session to formulate a competing measure. The amount of
38	additional General Fund appropriations that will be required for the daily expense allowance of Legislators, estimated to be
40	\$13,160 per day for all Legislators, and the cost of retaining session-only staff can not be determined at this time.'
