2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7457, sub-§1, ¶E, as amended by PL 1983, c.
4	271, is further amended to read:
6	E. The commissioner may shorten the open season on deer in any part of the State, provided that:
8	(1) The demarcation of the areas with the shortened
10	season follow recognizable physical boundaries, such as rivers and railroad rights-of-way;
12	(2) The determination is made and published prior to
14	June 1st of any year; and
16	(3) The Saturday <u>and Sunday</u> preceding the first day of open season on deer <del>skall-be-an <u>are</u> open day <u>days</u> for</del>
18	residents of this State only.

24	This bill allows resident-only hunting on the Sunday preceding the open season on deer, immediately following the resident-only Saturday hunting.
