2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7458, sub-§4-A,** as enacted by PL 1979, c.
723, §18-E, is amended to read:

6 **4-A. Keeping an unregistered deer.** A person is guilty,
8 except as provided in subsection 15, paragraph G, of keeping an
unregistered deer if he that person keeps an unregistered deer at
10 his home, or at any place of storage except a deer registration
station, more than ~~12~~ 24 hours.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill increases to 24 hours the time limit for
