

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §773**, as amended by PL 1993, c. 434, §2, is
amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

6 Notwithstanding this section, minors who are 15 years of age
8 or older may be employed at games of skill by commercial places
of amusement.
