Sec. 3. Study. The Interagency Task Force on Homelessness and Housing Opportunities shall study and provide recommendations to the Legislature and the Governor by December 1, 1997 on:

A. How best to provide affordable housing and homeless shelter services to those homeless persons with mental illness or substance abuse problems; and

B. The future role and responsibilities, if any, of the 30 interagency task force.

32 The study must include an inventory of the current safety and health requirements, licenses and permits applicable to homeless 34 shelters, including shelters for families, adolescents, adults and victims of domestic violence.

Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

32	This amendment is the majority report of the committee. This amendment provides \$1,000,000 per year in funds to the Maine
34	State Housing Authority for use by homeless shelters to offset costs incurred by increased occupancy in the State's homeless shelters. This amendment reduces and strengthens the membership
36	of the Interagency Task Force on Homelessness and Housing Opportunities and directs it to report to the Governor and
38	Legislature on how best to provide affordable housing and homeless shelter services to persons with mental illness and to
40	make recommendations on the future role and responsibilities of the task force. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
