2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §652, sub-§13**, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is repealed.

6 **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §652, sub-§§14 and 15**, as enacted by PL 1993,
8 c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, are amended to read:

10 **14. Salvage vehicle.** A salvage vehicle with a certificate
of salvage or other comparable document from another state; and

12 **15. Other vehicles.** A vehicle required to be registered
14 under section 109, subsection 3 for which a current certificate
of title has been issued in another state; and

16 **Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §652, sub-§16** is enacted to read:

18 **16. Vehicles more than 10 years old.** A vehicle with a
20 model year more than 10 years older than the current model year.

22 **SUMMARY**

24 This bill allows a vehicle more than 10 years old to be
registered without a title.
