

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1301, sub-§2,** as enacted by PL 1993, c.  
683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

6 **2. Contents.** The applicant must provide specific answers  
8 that demonstrate the experience and competence of the applicant  
to operate a motor vehicle. The application must contain a  
10 question, which the applicant shall answer, as to whether the  
applicant has ever suffered a stroke or a cerebrovascular  
12 accident.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill requires an applicant for a driver's license to  
18 answer a question on the application as to whether the applicant  
has ever suffered a cerebrovascular accident, commonly referred  
20 to as a stroke.
