2. Contents. The applicant must provide specific answers that demonstrate the experience and competence of the applicant to operate a motor vehicle. The application must contain a question, which the applicant shall answer, as to whether the applicant has ever suffered a stroke or a cerebrovascular accident.

## SUMMARY

This bill requires an applicant for a driver's license to answer a question on the application as to whether the applicant has ever suffered a cerebrovascular accident, commonly referred to as a stroke.
