26	'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

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Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

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'Sec. 3. Emergency clause; referendum; effective date. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved, except that section 2 of this Act takes effect only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters within the Waldoboro Utility District at an election to be called and held for that purpose by December 31, 1998. The election must be called by the municipal officers of the Town of Waldoboro and must be held at the regular voting places. The election must be called, advertised and conducted according to the law relating to municipal elections; except that the board of registration is not required to prepare nor the town clerk to post a new list of The board of registration must be in session on the 3 working days next preceding the election, the first and 2nd days to be devoted to registration of voters and the last day to enable the board to verify the corrections of the lists and to complete and close their records of the session. The town clerk shall reduce the subject matter of section 2 of this Act to the following question:

"Do you favor amending the Waldoboro Utility District charter by changing the debt limit of the district from \$1,000,000 to \$2,000,000 and removing the requirement that any single expenditure in excess of \$100,000 be approved by district vote?"

Section 2 of this Act takes effect for all purposes immediately upon acceptance by a majority of the legal voters at the election, but only if the total number of votes cast for and against its acceptance exceeds 10% of the registered voters of the district, but failure of approval does not prevent subsequent elections held prior to December 31, 1998.

The results of the election must be declared by the municipal officers of the town and due certificate of the election must be filed by the town clerk with the Secretary of State.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires the Waldoboro Utility District to hold a public election. The additional costs of this state mandate are relatively minor. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.'
