2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §3907, sub-§8,** as amended by PL 1995, c. 490,
§1, is further amended to read:

6 **8. Boarding kennel.** "Boarding kennel" means any place,
building, tract of land or abode in or on which 3 or more
8 privately owned dogs or other pets, or both, are kept at any one
time for their owners in return for a fee.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill amends the definition of "boarding kennel" to
include only facilities that keep 3 or more pets.
