COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 294, L.D. 945, Bill, "An Act to Establish Basic Standards and Procedures for Personal Services Contracting by the State"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S1816-A.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the 3rd line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "these criteria" and inserting in its place the following: 'this criterion'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S1816-A.~~" by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 3, lines 6 to 24 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'3. Contract information retained. Departments or agencies submitting proposed contracts shall retain all data, including written findings, relevant to the contracts and necessary for a specific application of the standards set forth in subsections 1 and 2.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs to administer a review process for certain state contracts can be absorbed by the Division of Purchases within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

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4 The amendment strikes out all of the Maine Revised Statutes,
6 Title 5, section 1816-A, subsection 3 and replaces it with
 language that requires a department to retain the data for any
 proposals for contracts.
