- Finance Authority of Maine sponsored credit card. The Finance Authority of Maine may enter into an agreement with a financial institution, as defined in Title 9-B, section 131, subsection 17 or a credit union, as defined in Title 9-B, section 10 131, subsection 12 to issue a credit card for the benefit of the Scholarships for Maine Fund.
- 2. Agreement. If the Finance Authority of Maine enters
  into an agreement with a financial institution or credit union in
  accordance with subsection 1, the Finance Authority of Maine
  shall negotiate the most favorable agreement for the Finance
  Authority of Maine, considering such factors as:
  - A. The rate of the fee by a credit card issuer;
  - B. The ability of a financial institution or credit union to market the card successfully; and
    - C. Customer service offered by the financial institution or credit union.
- 3. Distribution of proceeds. Funds received by the Finance Authority of Maine under the agreement with the financial institution or credit union must be deposited into the Scholarships for Maine Fund.
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**SUMMARY** 

This bill authorizes the Fimance Authority of Maine to enter into an agreement with a financial institution or a credit union 36 for a sponsored credit card. The purpose of the credit card is to provide voluntary funding for the Scholarships for Maine Fund 38 from which grants are made to students who evidence financial 40 need when attending an accredited postsecondary education program. The bill also updates the list of the higher education 42 assistance programs the Finance Authority of Maine is authorized to administer.
