2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2452, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

6 4. Grandfathering. Structures in existence before  
8 September 1, 1994 are not subject to the rules adopted by the  
10 commissioner under this section.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill grandfathers structures existing before September  
16 1, 1994 from Life Safety Code 101 requirements regarding fire  
doors and exits.
