SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits the stocking of alewives in Tripp Pond in Poland, in Hogan Pond and Whitney Pond in Oxford, in any waters that drain into those ponds, in the brook that drains those ponds and in the Little Androscoggin River upstream of the Welchville dam.

These provisions are repealed 90 days after the adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the 118th Legislature.

This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
