SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 16 734, L.D. 998, "An Act to Amend the Certificate of Need Laws"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 6. Reimbursement. Resolved: That the commission members
who are Legislators are entitled to receive the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section
24 2, and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses for attendance at meetings of the commission. Other members are not
26 entitled to compensation or reimbursement of expenses; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 8 30 and inserting in its place the following:

32 'Sec. 8. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of 34 this resolve.
