<b>30</b>	The amendment requires any person who violates the vehicle

The amendment requires any person who violates the vehicle liability insurance and financial responsibility laws to provide the Secretary of State proof of financial responsibility. It also amends the bill by requiring that a system for the electronic filing of vehicle insurance apply only to people who violate the vehicle insurance laws. The bill proposed that the system apply to all people with registered vehicles. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
