Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1.	5	MRSA	§17656,	sub-§2	is	enacted	to	read:

2. Teachers with previous employment as a teacher's aide with a participating local district. A member who is a teacher may elect to include creditable service and earnable compensation as a teacher's aide with a previous employer that is a participating local district that is a school administrative unit with creditable service and earnable compensation of the current employer. If the teacher makes the election provided in this subsection, all funds in the retirement system contributed by the member's former employer on account of the member's previous employment must be transferred to the account of the new employer and must be used to liquidate the liability incurred by reason of the previous employment.

SUMMARY

This bill allows teachers covered under the retirement system to include in creditable service and earnable compensation, employment as a teacher's aide with a participating local district that is a school administrative unit.
