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Sec. 1. 18-A MRSA §3-804, sub-§(4) is enacted to read:

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(4) When a decedent's estate has not been commenced at the time a claimant wishes to present a claim, a claim is deemed presented when the claimant files with the clerk of the court a written statement of claim meeting the requirements of subsection (1) and a demand for notice pursuant to section 3-204. The provisions of subsection (3) apply upon the appointment of a personal representative.

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## **SUMMARY**

16 This bill allows a creditor of a deceased person, whose estate has not yet been filed, to present the creditor's claim in a simple manner without requiring the creditor to initiate the 18 probate of the estate. Once the probate estate is filed and a 20 personal representative appointed, the personal representative may disallow or allow the claim.
