	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2084, sub-§§3 and 4 are enacted to read:

	3. Helmet. A person under 16 years of age who is operating
6	or is a passenger on a bicycle shall wear a helmet. For the
	purposes of this subsection, to wear a helmet means having a
8	helmet of good fit fastened securely upon the head with the
	helmet straps.

	4. Violation. Any person who violates subsection 3 commits
12	a civil violation for which a civil forfeiture not to exceed \$25
	may be adjudged. This fine may be waived if a receipt is
14	produced within 72 hours of the violation demonstrating that the
	person has purchased a helmet.

18	SUMMARY
20	This bill authorizes the State to promote the health and
	safety of a person under 16 years of age who is operating a
22	bicycle or is a passenger on a bicycle by requiring that person
	to wear a bicycle helmet.
