Sec. 1. Task force established. Resolved: That the Task Force on 2 Research and Development Investment, referred to in this resolve as "task force," is established to enhance the State's ability to 4 develop projects that lead to the creation of new businesses and jobs; and be it further Sec. 2. Task force membership. Resolved: That the task force consists of the following 10 members: 10 Two representatives from within the University of Maine System, appointed by the Chancellor of the University of Maine 12 System; 14 Two representatives from within the Maine Technical College System, appointed by the President of the Maine Technical 16 College System; members from the Maine Chamber 18 3. and Business Two Alliance, appointed by the President of the Maine Chamber and Business Alliance; 20 Two members from the Maine Development Foundation, 22 appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Maine Development 24 Foundation; The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development 26 or the commissioner's designee; and 28 The Director of the State Planning Office or 30 director's designee; and be it further 32 Sec. 3. Appointments; meetings. Resolved: That all appointments must be made no later than 30 days following the effective date The Executive Director of the Legislative of this resolve. 34 Council must be notified by all appointing authorities once the selections have been made. Within 15 days after the appointment 36 of all members, the Chair of the Legislative Council shall call and convene the first meeting of the task force. The task force 38 shall select a chair from among its members; and be it further 40 Sec. 4. Duties. Resolved: That the task force shall conduct a 42 study to determine the capital and human resource investment necessary to significantly improve the State's economy. force shall determine the steps and human resources required to 44
