SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 771, L.D. 1048, "Resolve, to Establish a Task Force to Review the Regional Applied Technology Centers"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 39 in amendment) by striking out the following: "10" and inserting in its place the following: '11'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Two legislative members appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House, one of whom must be a member of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs and one of whom must be a member of the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans' Affairs;'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in subsection 5 (page 2, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "accountability; and" and inserting in its place the following: 'accountability;'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in subsection 6 in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 50 and 51 in amendment) by striking out the following: "; and be it further" and inserting in its place the following: '; and'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 by inserting at the end the following:

(page 3, line 8 in amendment) by inserting after the following:

Legislative Council'

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS



The Legislature will require a General Fund appropriation of \$630 in fiscal year 1997-98 for the per diem and expenses of the legislative members of the Task Force to Review the Applied Technology Centers and Applied Technology Regions.

SUMMARY

This amendment adds an additional legislative member to the Task Force to Review the Applied Technology Centers and Applied Technology Regions; provides that the 2 legislative members, one of whom must be a member of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs and one of whom must be a member of the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans' Affairs, must be appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House; and gives the legislative members per diem and expenses. The amendment also requires the task force to review the issue of competition with the private sector, including strategies to minimize that competition.
