SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 771, L.D. 1048, "Resolve, to Establish a Task Force to Review the Regional Applied Technology Centers"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 39 in amendment) by striking out the following: "10" and inserting in its place the following: '11'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Two legislative members appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House, one of whom must be a member of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs and one of whom must be a member of the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans' Affairs;'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in subsection 5 (page 2, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "accountability; and" and inserting in its place the following: 'accountability;'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in subsection 6 in the first and 2nd lines (page 2, lines 50 and 51 in amendment) by striking out the following: "; and be it further" and inserting in its place the following: '; and'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 by inserting at the end the following:

'7. Competition with the private sector, including strategies to minimize that competition; and be it further'

2 Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 6  
4 (page 3, lines 6 to 10 in amendment) and inserting in its place  
the following:

6 'Sec. 6. Reimbursement. Resolved: That the members of the

legislative per diem as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes,  
10 Title 3, section 2 and expenses for attendance at meetings of the  
task force upon application to the Executive Director of the  
12 Legislative Council; and be it further'

14 Further amend the amendment in section 7 in the last line  
(page 3, line 20 in amendment) by striking out the following:  
16 "extension." and inserting in its place the following:  
'extension; and be it further'

18 Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 7 the  
20 following:

22 'Sec. 8. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are  
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of  
24 this resolve.
